The Kansas Range Youth Camp is held at **Camp Mennoscah in Kingman County, KS**. It is designed to give the students a basic understanding of the principles of rangeland ecology, including plant physiology, plant identification, range sites, range condition, and trend. Students selected to participate should have a serious interest in rangeland management, rangeland ecology, or grazing animals.

Each camper will receive a camp information packet via mail by late May. This packet will include location maps, agenda, what to bring, etc. During camp each participant will receive a range youth camp t-shirt and notebook filled with presentations and handouts. After camp a CD-ROM of pictures highlighting activities at the camp will be mailed to each participant. Copies can also be made for sponsors for presentation purposes upon request.
