

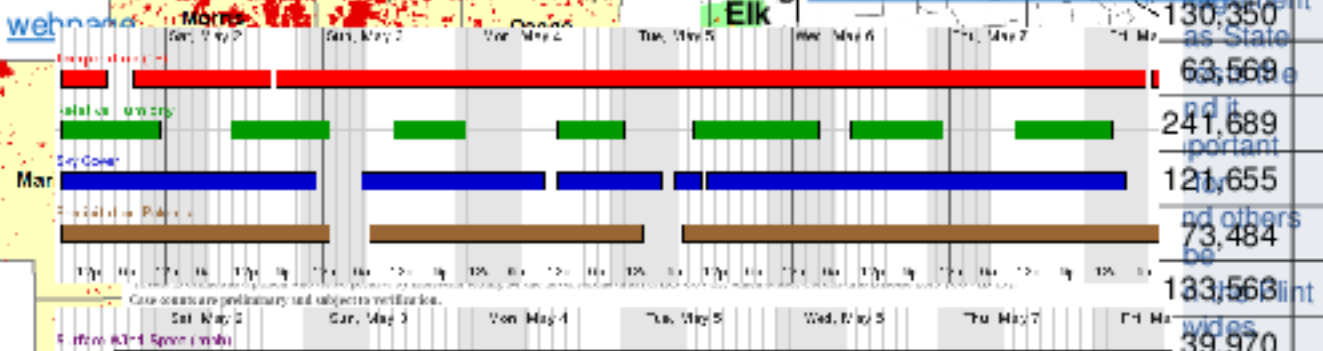
Flint Hills Prescribed Fire Update

Flint Hills Acreage Burned (February 9, April 15, 2020)

On March 28, 2020, the forecast Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) and the Kansas Department of Agriculture (KDA) reported that the Flint Hills area has burned 25 and 208,515 acres, respectively, since the start of the fire season. 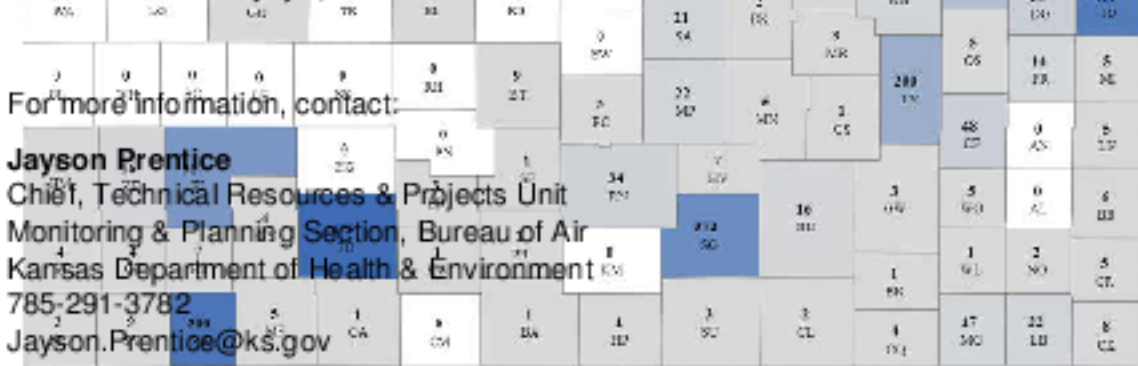
Ideal Weather Conditions for Prescribed Burning
